Tree to be cut between nov 1st and April possible contractor to do it. currently underbudget by 20% \$37,000 but some bills are coming in.

Only the selectman must discuss and decide to opt-in or out, it does not have to be a public vote, but the selectman said they would leave the discussion to the town. It's going to be discussed at the planning board's sept meeting.

- 7. Amt marsh is concerned regarding getting a possible ordinance to prohibit the mandating for people to be able to seek asylum in Whiting. Selectmen have a copy of the letter regarding her concerns. They would have to check in with MMA, state laws to see if even a possibility.
